

How can you add the AIACC to your site?

„Raw“ HTML/CSS sites

Just add the following four lines before the final `</html>` section for every page so that they appear on every page within the site.



<script src='https://www.aiacc.eu/aiacc/aiacc_version1/aiacc.js'></script>
<div class='aiacc_version1' id='aiacc_version1_placeholder'></div>
<script type='text/javascript'>$(document).ready(function() {
aiacc_version1_document(10, 10, window); });</script>
```

If your site doesn't use jquery at all, then add two more lines before that.

<script src='https://ajax.googleapis.com/ajax/libs/jquery/3.5.1/jquery.js'></script>

Wordpress sites

Try adding AIACC code snippets to your Wordpress header (or footer) code snippets. See the example in the following picture:

As a result, an AIACC icon should appear on the bottom right of the page. By clicking on it, all the tools described on our site should become available. You can change the location of the icon by specifying other values instead (10,10), that indicate the distance from the lower right corner of the display.

You can test the AIACC tool without restrictions for at least 10 days. If you continue to use the tool after the specified period, an additional icon will appear.



If you are satisfied with the tool, you could register it. After registering the tool and paying the annual usage price within a maximum of 24 hours, the usage icon will disappear and you can use the tool normally for the next year. If you register the tool before the 10-day trial period expires, the icon about using the unregistered version will not be displayed at all.

If the tool does not work well on your site, because the design/template or the technologies used, simply delete the extra lines mentioned before and remove it. Trial use for testing is completely free.
